DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

General Statement of Duties: A position assisting in the fabric laying operation of the district.

Supervision Received: Works under the supervision of the Fabric Crew Leader in conjunction with the District Manager.

List of Duties: (The listed examples may not include all duties associated with this position.)

*Assists with the District's fabric laying program. This includes the safe operation, maintenance and management of the district equipment.

*Work day start time will be at the discretion of the District Manager and will be communicated to the Fabric crew the day before. The work day will start and end at the District site of 565 Nevada.

*Work day will end when inventory and supplies have been unloaded.

*One half hour is allowed for lunch and a fifteen minute break may be taken both morning and afternoon, keeping in mind that the tree season is short and there are many acres to cover. Breaks could be taken while driving to another site in order to save time.

*Assists in loading the fabric and staples for the working day.

*Makes sure the cuts in the fabric are made correctly and takes care with pulling the trees through the cut. Uses staples as directed. Handles the utility knife with care.

*All duties and actions taken while performing the requirements of this position will be done in a safe manner and will be of a nature to reflect favorably on the Beadle Conservation District.
