

**JOB DESCRIPTION
TREE PLANTER
BEADLE CONSERVATION DISTRICT**

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

General Statement of Duties: A position assisting in the tree planting operations of the district.

Supervision Received: Works under the supervision of the Tree Supervisor in conjunction with the District Manager.

List of Duties: (The listed examples may not include all duties associated with this position.)

*Assists with the District's tree planting program. This includes the safe operation, maintenance and management of the district equipment.

*Work day start time will be at the discretion of the District Manager and will be communicated to the Tree Planting crew the day before. The work day will start and end at the District site of 565 Nevada.

*Work day will end when inventory and supplies have been unloaded. One half hour is allowed for lunch and a fifteen minute break may be taken both morning and afternoon, keeping in mind that the planting season is short and there are many acres to cover. Breaks could be taken while driving to another site to save time.

*Assists with loading and unloading trees for days planting taking care to load correct boxes.

*Secure all Equipment and Trees.

*Takes care with nursery stock, keeping roots covered as much as possible.

*Plants trees exactly as shown on tree plan unless "change order" has been obtained from District Manager.

*All duties and actions taken while performing the requirements of this position will be done in a safe manner and will be of a nature to reflect favorably on the Beadle Conservation District.
